Post processing workflow

Either using Lightroom or Photo Camera Raw the following adjustments can be used as a starting point.

Basic Adjustments to Tone:

- Exposure More or less depending on original
- Contrast add 5 to 10
- Highlights decrease to about -25, sometimes even as much as -100
- Shadows add up to 25-50
- Whites add 5
- Blacks add 5

Adjustments to Contrast:

- Texture increase to bring out edges and detail, decrease to smooth out detail
- Clarity increase to exaggerate the mid tone contrasts, decrease to soften
- Dehaze add 5
- Vibrance add 5
- Saturation add 5
- Under Tone Curve:
 - Highlights Depending on the image, increase or decrease
 - Lights add 5
 - Darks decrease -5
 - Shadows decrease -5

Under Color Grading, try making adjustments to warm up the overall color:

- Midtones, Shadows, & Highlights play with the sliders to achieve the look you want
- Blending Between 50-100
- Balance +5

There is no right or wrong adjustments, with ICM you can push sliders to their limits if it produces the look you like.

Colours do not need to be "realistic"
